

# FAUNA

**There are many species of mammals, birds, amphibians and insects in forests. The most characteristic animals are: deer, foxes, wild boars, squirrels and hedgehogs. Near rivers or lakes, beavers can be found. They build their dams there.**





**Red squirrel- lives in woodlands and parks. It eats mainly seeds, nuts and berries. Squirrels collect food for winter season. In Poland they are protected species.**





**Fox – a carnivorous mammal with a bushy tail, lives in woodlands and fields. The most common species of fox is the red fox.**



**Hedgehog- an omnivorous mammal, living in woodland, farmland, parks and gardens. Hedgehogs are nocturnal. Their body is covered with spines.**





**The Black stork- a large wading bird, nearly 1m tall with 1.8m wingspan. It is rare species, lives mainly in wetlands or woodlands and builds a nest high in trees. The black stork feeds on amphibians, insects and fish. It is a protected bird.**
